

## **14 BACnet Certified Products**

### **Successful Finale to the First Round of European BACnet Certification**

**Dortmund/Frankfurt, Germany – 9th April 2008 – The first certificates in Europe were awarded to 14 manufacturers whose products successfully passed the BACnet Standard ISO 16484-5 conformity test. Volker Röhl, President of the BACnet Interest Group (BIG-EU) and Frank Bitter from WSP presented the certificates at light+building.**

Building automation products from ABB Oy Drives, Delta Controls, Fr. Sauter, Honeywell, HSC Regelungstechnik, Johnson Controls, Kieback&Peter, Neuberger Gebäudeautomation, Plüth Regelsysteme, Priva, Saia-Burgess Controls, Samson, Siemens and TAC were all awarded. The BIG-EU also gave out the worldwide recognised BTL mark. Application for the two awards was made by the companies following the conformance tests.

The certification sets the highest standard for premium product testing in Europe and is conducted by an independent, recognised test laboratory. Users are therefore assured that the functions they require are available and tested.

The BTL mark is furthermore a visible symbol for tested conformity. All products with the BTL mark are listed by the BIG-EU or the American BACnet International. Both user associations recognise BACnet conformity.
