- 1998**
  - Foundation of BIG-EU
  - EN V 13321 (automation level)
  - Beginning of global standardization
  - ISO TC 205 WG 3
- 1997**
  - ISO TC 205 WG 3
  - EN V 1805-1 (management level)
- 1995**
  - First standardization in the USA
  - BACnet becomes ANSI / ASHRAE standard 135-1995
- 1987**
  - ASHRAE constitutes BACnet Committee SSPC 135
- 1985**
  - Mike Newman developed an open computer for the various automation systems at Cornell University, USA
